After a long and thoughtful period the central organising team for UK Urban League Orienteering have decided to rebrand the Nopepsort Urban League for the remaining events being run in 2014 and for future years.

The Nopepsort Urban League will from now on be known as the UK Urban League. Please could you therefore refer to your urban event as an **UK Urban League Event** from now on, as well as any regional league your event is also part of (Eg SEOUL) but no longer include the name Nopepsort?

By making this change now the organisers of the UK Urban Orienteering League hope to establish a secure future for national urban orienteering. Any publicity material you have already produced that includes Nopepsort's name and logo is still fine to use; do not go to any expense changing flyers unless you are already planning to have them reprinted. If you could alter your website details however this would be appreciated. The Logo for the UK Urban League is at the top of this letter and I have included it with this e-mail for your use instead. Please let me know if you require the logo in a different format.

There are no changes planned for the format of the UK league, the events selected for 2014, the courses being included or the method of downloading results. Brian Ward and Roger Thetford are available should you need further details about this.

The central organising team for UK Urban League Orienteering is very grateful for the prompt and positive responses received from urban event organisers and their clubs when we took on finalizing the 2014 UK league programme. Preliminary plans for 2015 are at an early stage and we will be in touch with regional urban league organisers, clubs and fixtures secretaries later this year.
