Download Condes 9 (install_condes9.exe) from the Download page and scan the download to check for those nasty viruses! In fact always, always scan anything you download from the net.

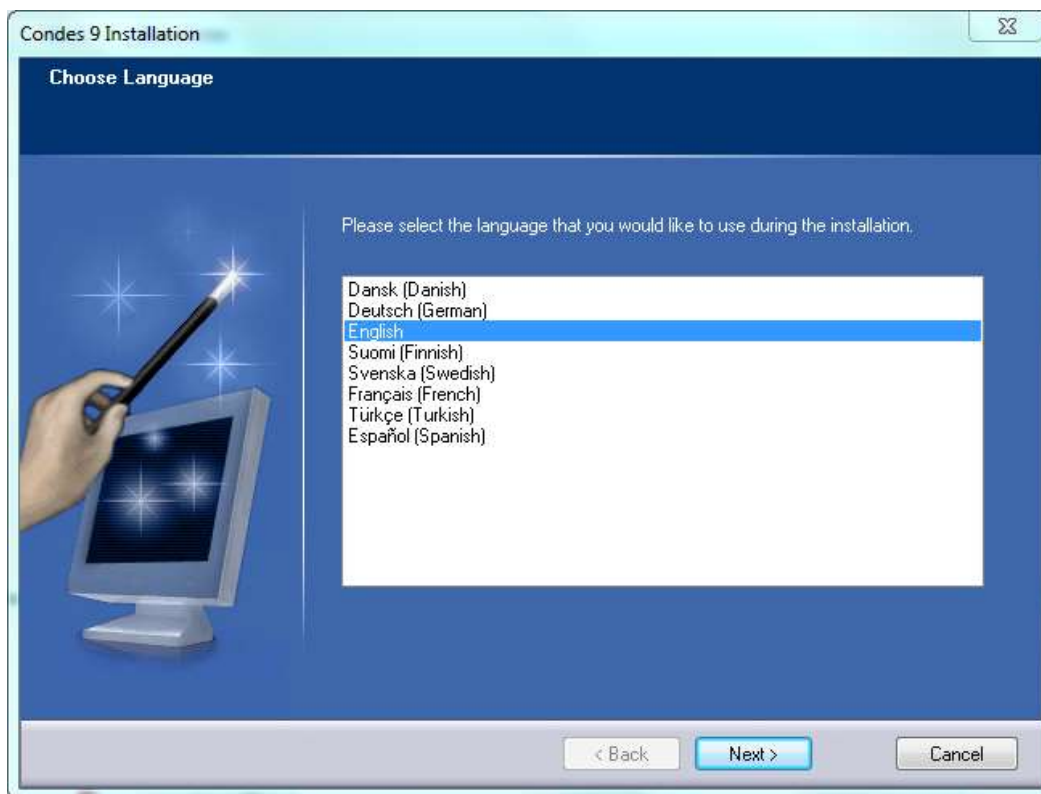

Installation

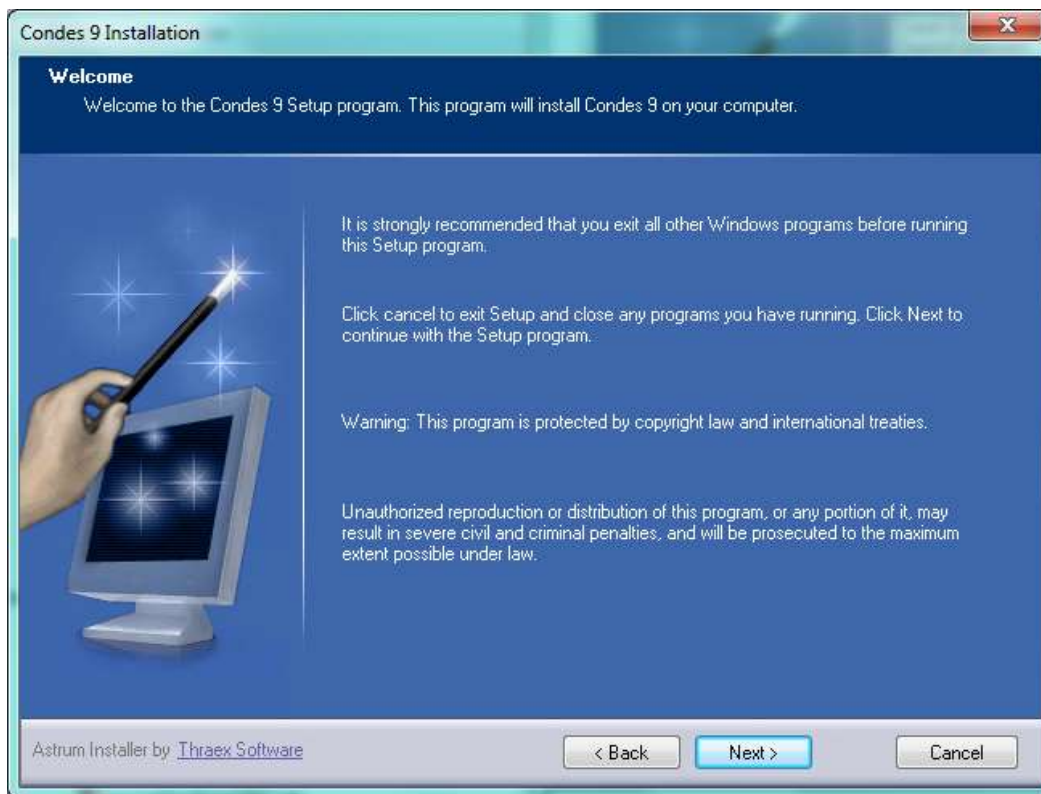
Use the downloaded install_condes9.exe file to install the Condes 9 product.

Licence terms

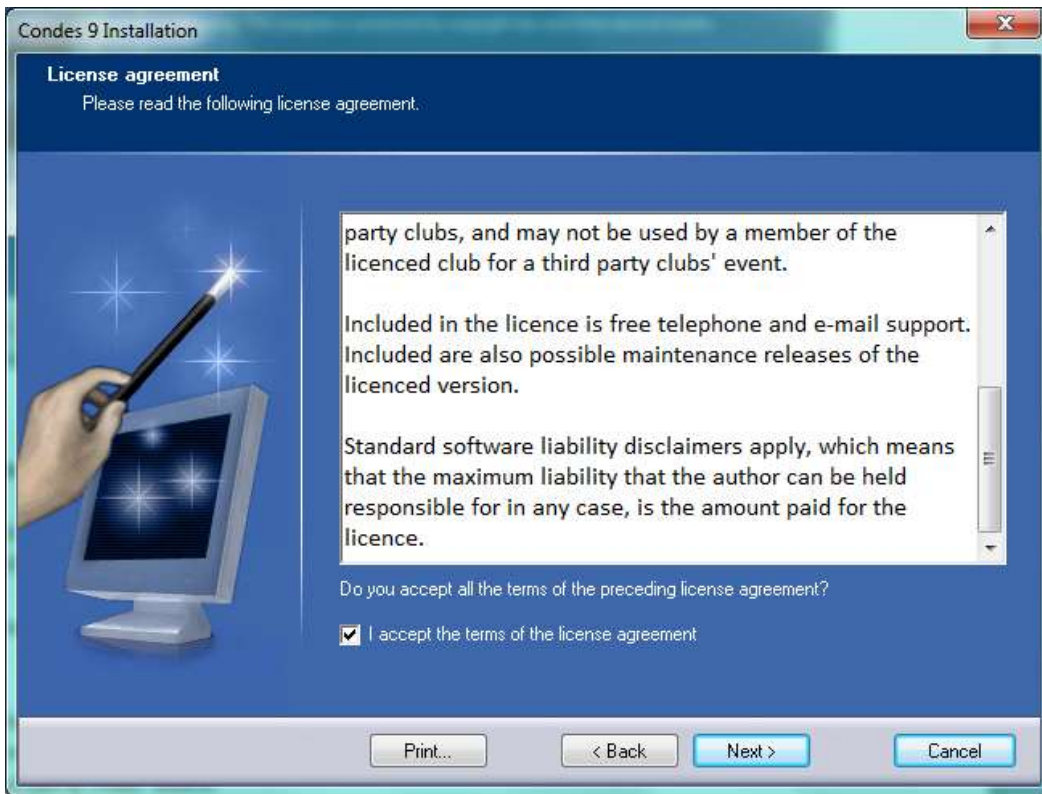
Condes is a bit more favourable than most other software in its licencing terms, in that a licence is valid for an entire orienteering club.

This means that Condes may be used by all the club's members for the licenced club's events.

However, it should be mentioned that the terms also means that a licenced copy of Condes may not be lent out to third party clubs, and may not be used by a member of the licenced club for a third party clubs' event.

Included in the licence is free telephone and e-mail support. Included are also possible maintenance releases of the licenced version.

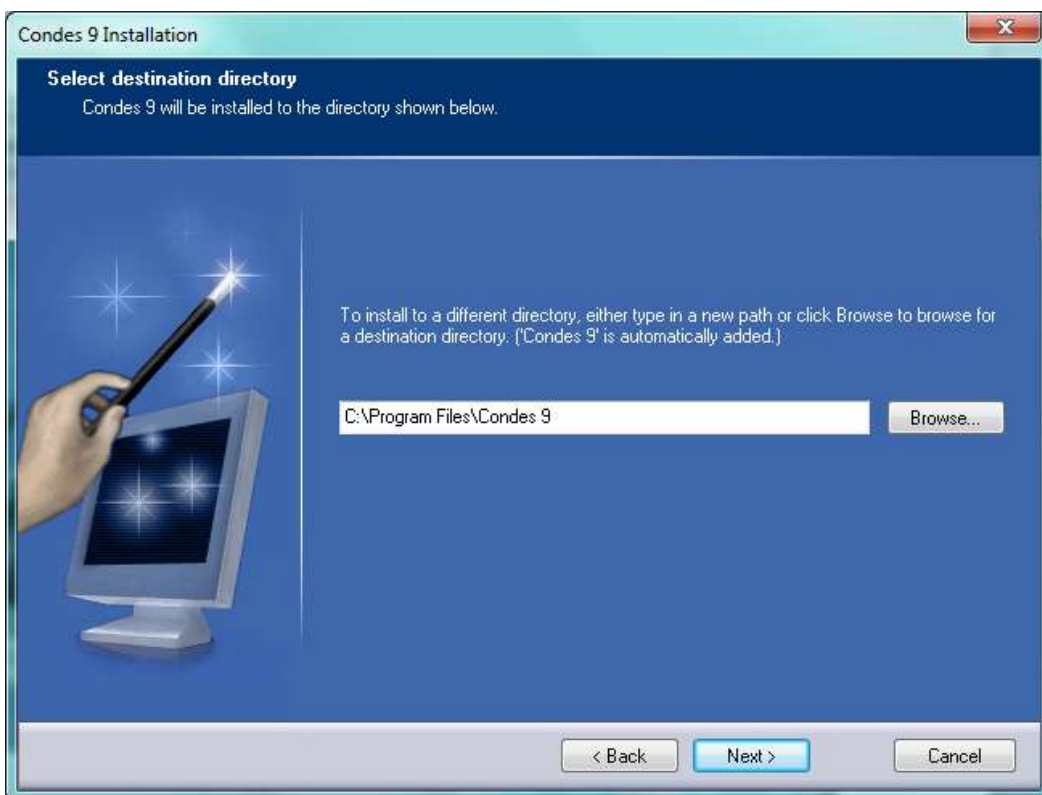
Standard software liability disclaimers apply, which means that the maximum liability that the author can be held responsible for in any case, is the amount paid for the licence.



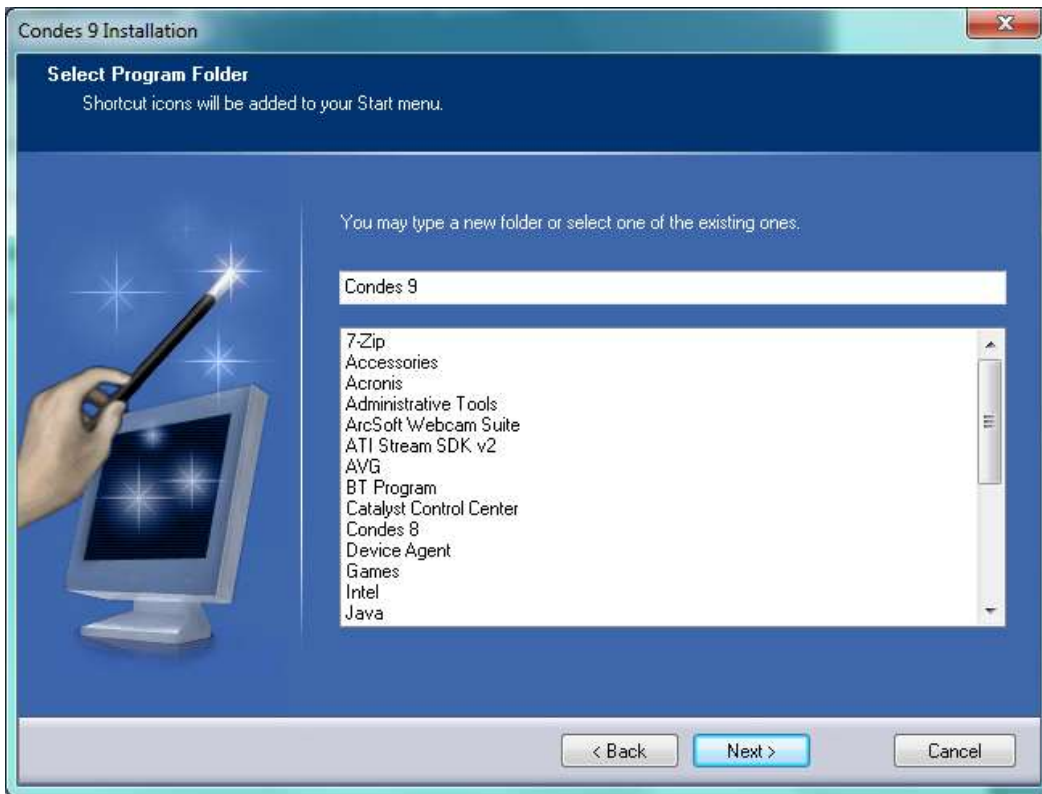
Accept the terms of the license agreement as the club has bought a Condes 9 club licence.

Note: Condes 8 and Condes 9 can co-exist

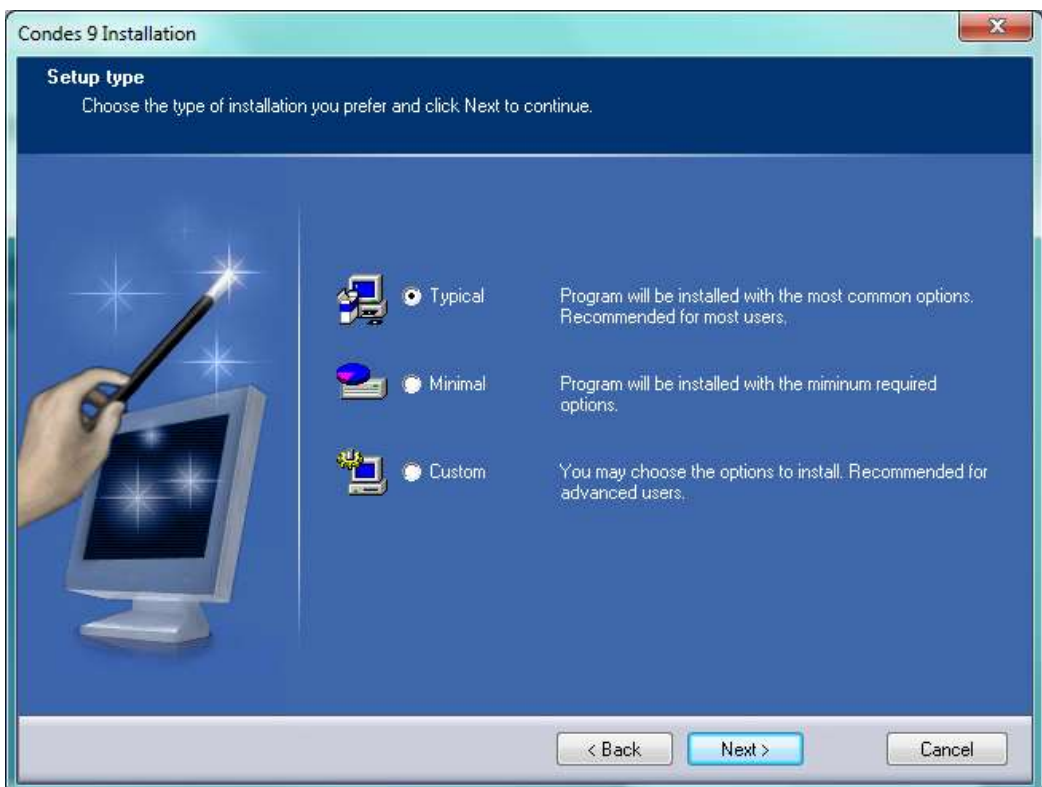

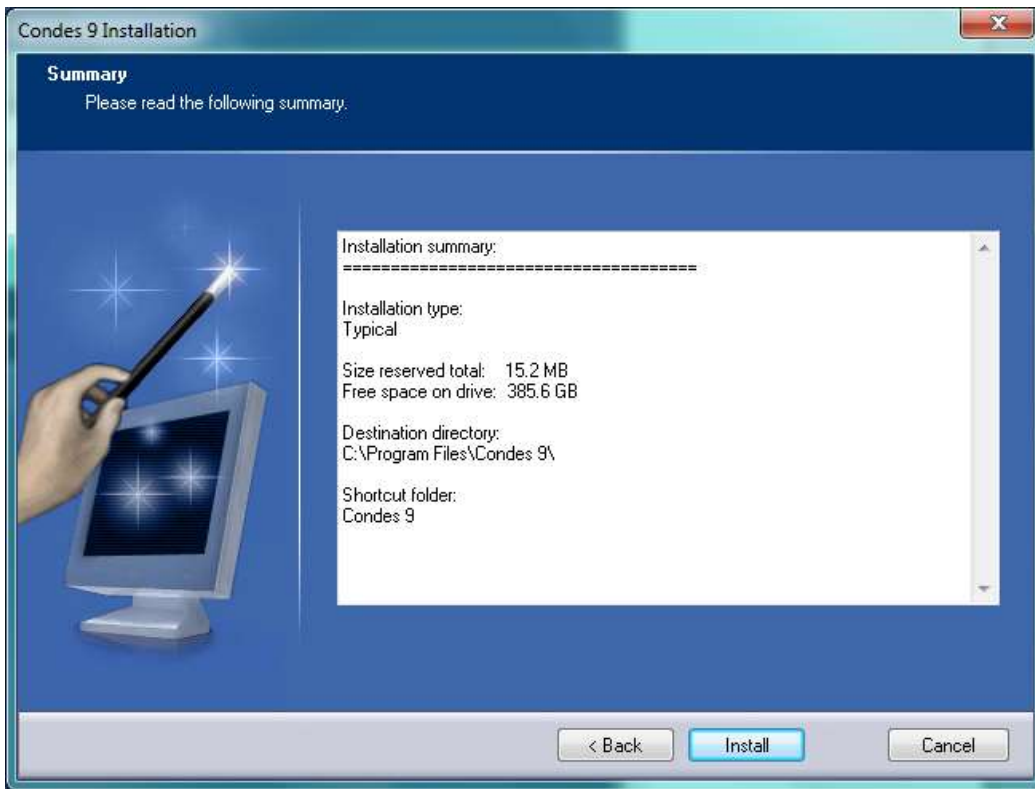
Choose an appropriate Program Folder by taking the default, selecting an existing folder or creating a new one.

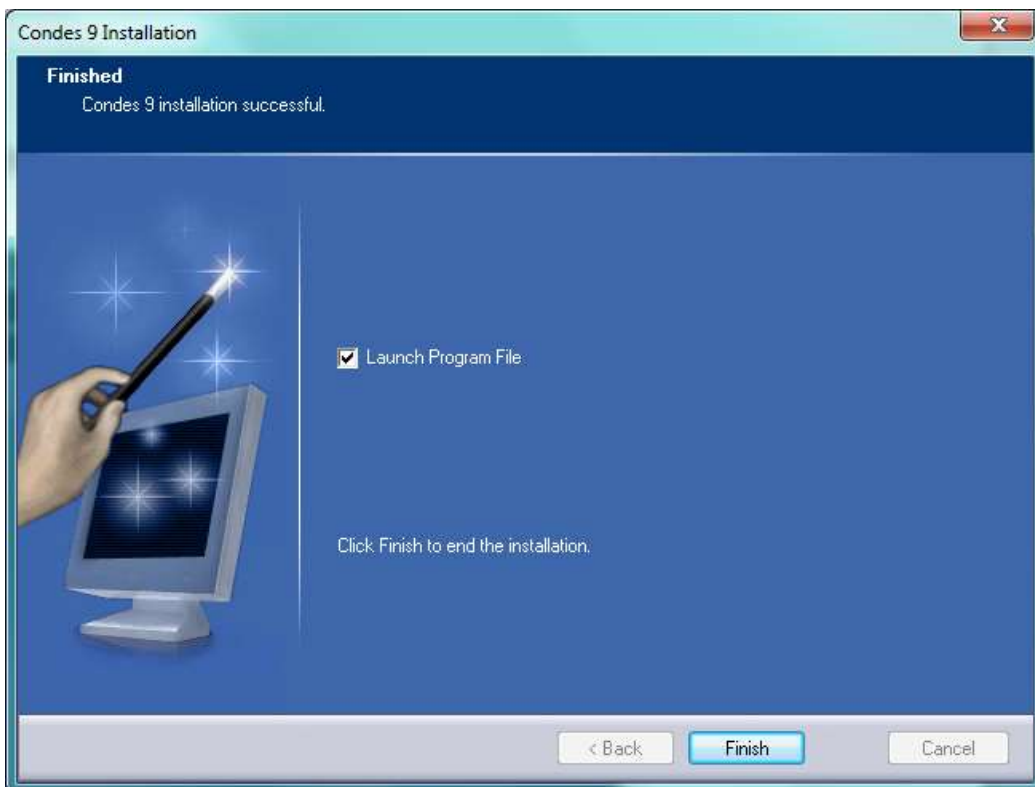

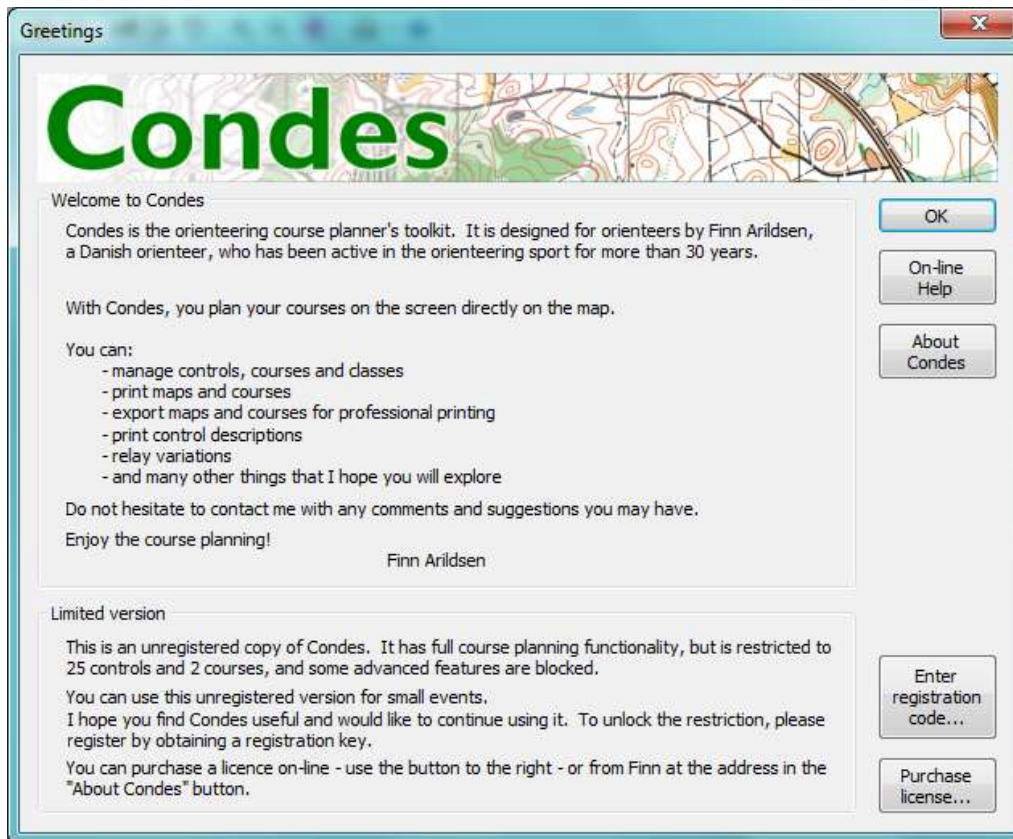

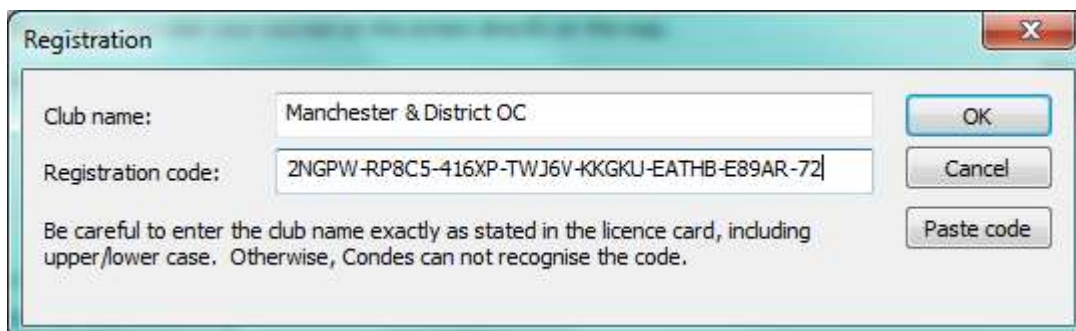

Finish – leaving the check box checked will let you enter the registration key now



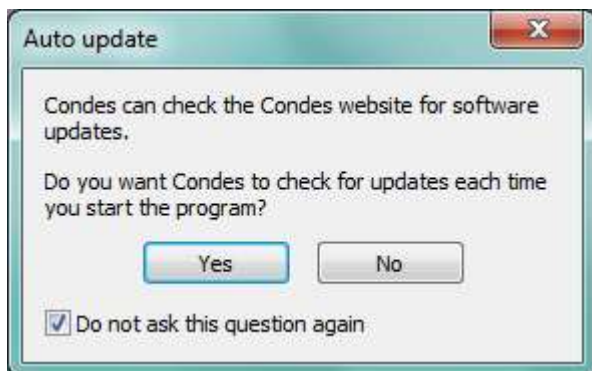

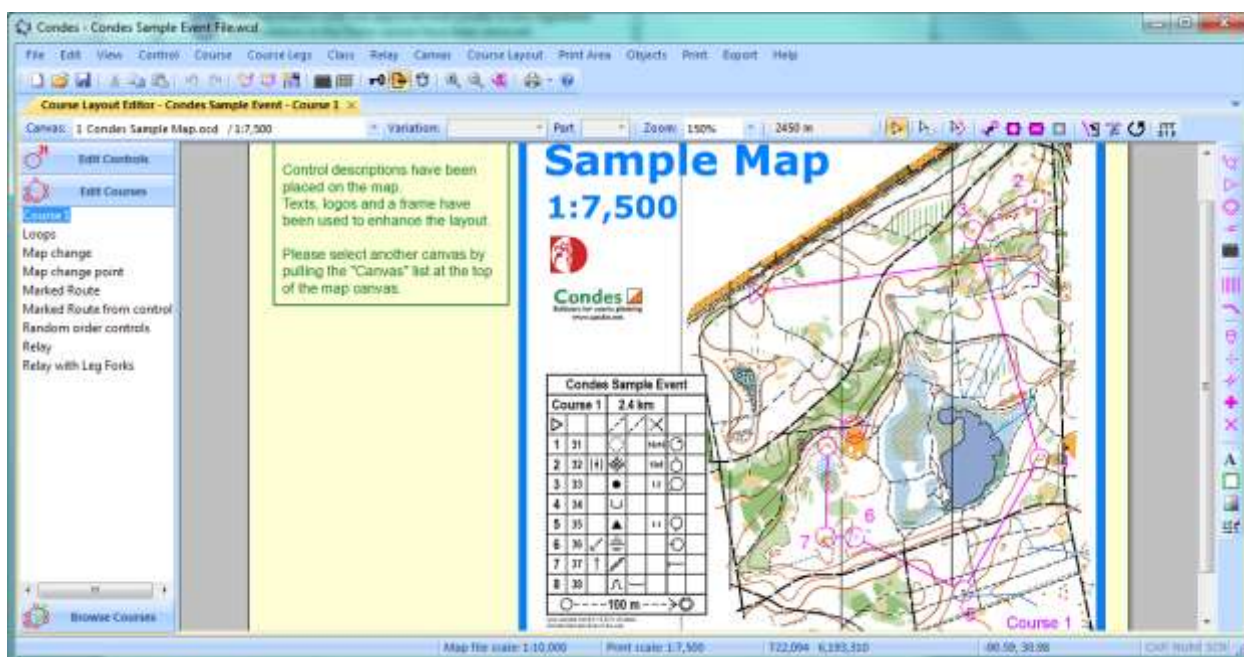
