Notes: The Trophy round has 8 clubs so the first two qualify for the final.

Notes: Trophy: If INT and FVO are first and second (in any order) then the third and fourth placed teams qualify for the final. If only one of either INT or FVO finish first or second then the third placed team qualifies for the final. In this case if the third placed team is the other of INT or FVO then the fourth placed team also qualifies. If neither INT nor FVO finish first or second then only the first two teams qualify for the final.
