HIS CLINICAL PRACTICES CURRENTLY INCLUDE ADDICTION MEDICINE AND CORRECTIONAL HEALTHCARE. HE TEACHES IN THE SCHOOL OF MEDICINE, THE PA PROGRAM, THE CENTER FOR INTERPROFESSIONAL EDUCATION AND RESEARCH, AND THE SCHOOL OF LAW. HE IS THE MEDICAL DIRECTOR FOR THE ASSISTED RECOVERY CENTERS OF AMERICAN (ARCA).

SHE RECEIVED HER DOCTORATE IN CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI AND COMPLETED HER DOCTORAL INTERNSHIP WITH THE VA ST. LOUIS HEALTHCARE SYSTEM. HER PROFESSIONAL INTERESTS REVOLVE AROUND INTERVENTIONS DESIGNED TO SAVE AND IMPROVE THE LIVES OF PEOPLE WHO USE DRUGS.
